PRETRIAL INTERVENTION AGREEMEN

It being alleged you have committed an offense against the State of Florida on. 10/22/2020, to wit:

COUNT 1: FRAUD IN CONNECTION WITH CASTING A VOTE (F3) 104.041

COUNT 2: MAIL-IN BALLOT FRAUD (F3) 104.047(1)

and it further appearing after an investigation of the offense and into your background, that at this time the interest of the State of Florida, and your interest will best be served by the following agreement, the parties agree as follows:

On the authority of Phil Archer, State Attorney, in and for the Eighteenth Judicial Circuit, Seminole County, Florida, prosecution in this matter for said violation will be deferred for the period of TWENTY FOUR (24) MONTHS from this date, provided you abide by the following conditions:

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 1) You will live without violating the law. In the event of a criminal arrest (Federal, State or Local) while in the program you are subject to automatic dismissal. A conviction is not necessary for you to be terminated from the program.
- 2) You shall:
 - a) Work regularly at a lawful occupation and/or pursue a course of study as a full time student;
 - b) Participate in all programs established for you under the supervision of the Department of Corrections;
 - c) Not possess or carry any firearms or weapons while in the Pretrial Intervention Program:
 - d) Not change your residence or employment without first obtaining the consent of your Pretrial Intervention Officer:
 - e) Not leave the county of your residence without first procuring the consent of your Pretrial Intervention Officer:
 - f) Promptly and truthfully answer all inquiries by your Pre-Trial Intervention Officer and allow the Supervisor to visit your home, employment, school or elsewhere and you will comply with all instructions your officer may give you:
 - g) Not associate with any person or persons involved in any criminal activity;
 - h) Not use intoxicants to excess or possess any drugs or narcotics unless prescribed by a physician;
 - i) Submit to drug testing as determined by PTI Officer.

MONETARY OBLIGATIONS

- 3) You shall pay the following monetary obligations to the Florida Department of Corrections:
 - a) \$50.00 per month for cost of supervision:
 - b) Restitution in the amount of \$___ _____ jointly and severally if applicable, on behalf of PI-HLIP ALEXANDER DIME BAUER, 304-KEYES DRIVE, RUIDOSO, NM 88345
 - c) Cost of investigation in the amount of \$5,419.36, on behalf of FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT, payable to the Seminole County Clerk of the Court. PO BOX 8099. Sanford, FL 32772 at the minimum rate of \$250.00 per month.

- d) You shall pay \$100.00 cost of prosecution as authorized pursuant to Florida Statute 938.27, on behalf of the Office of the State Attorney for the 18th Judicial Circuit, payable to the Seminole County Clerk of the Court, PO BOX 8099, Sanford, FL 32772
- e) You shall pay \$100.00 to Crimeline, P. O. Box 913, Orlando, FL 32802.
- f) A onetime \$30.00 drug testing fee;
- g) \$1.00 per month to the Department of Corrections First Step program;
- h) Pursuant to Florida Statute 945.31, you must pay an additional 4% surcharge on all monetary payments collected by the Department of Corrections.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

	4) You shall complete 50 hours of community service work with a non-profit, tax exempt organization approved by your Pretrial Intervention Officer, at the rate of no less than 4 hours per month unless physically unable to do so as documented by your Officer and the following conditions as indicated: a) Drug evaluation and any recommended treatment; b) Anger Management Class c) Anti-Theft/Impulse Control Class d) Write a Letter of Apology to e) others 5) If you have successfully complied with all conditions of your supervision you may request early termination of supervision to your PTI Supervision Officer after completing six (6) months supervision. 6) The State Attorney may revoke or modify the conditions of your deferred prosecution by: a) Changing the period or the conditions of deferred prosecution. b) Prosecuting you for this offense if you violate any of these conditions. c) Voiding this agreement.
1	Upon successful completion of the period of this agreement, the charges filed by this office will be nolle prosequed. However, prosecution of this charge may be resumed at any time within one (1) year of completion of the program if the Defendant commits a new violation of the criminal law. The defendant will not apply for or otherwise obtain an expunction of records in this case during this one (1) year period.
