VOTING FRAUD MAKING FALSE AFFIDAVIT

THE JURORS FOR THE STATE UPON THEIR OATH PRESENT that on or about the 2<sup>RD</sup> day of March, 2016, in Hoke County, North Carolina, defendant named above unlawfully, willfully, and feloniously did knowingly swear falsely with respect to a matter pertaining to a primary or election to wit: the defendant swore to and affirmed on a North Carolina voter registration application that she had not been convicted of a felony, or if she had been convicted of a felony she had completed her sentence including probation, when in fact she had been convicted of a felony and was currently on probation. This act was in violation of North Carolina General Statutes Section 163-275(4).
